On the 22nd March, 2019 a devastating Cyclone hit our neighbouring country, Mozambique, with catastrophic consequences .

The Rotary Club of White River immediately put funds aside to purchase water purification sachets and sent them to the stricken areas via Mercy Air, an organisation which has mission stations in remote areas of Mozambique .

This way we could reach the population immediately and provide the means of obtaining 200 000 L of potable water without delay.

With the help of donations we are now able to send another consignment of purification sachets to Mozambique and thereby preventing the outbreak of Cholera in those remote areas.

We also contributed a sizeable amount to Rotary International for a Global Grant to purchase water Filtration plants for Mozambique to ensure a long-term solution for the provision of clean water.
